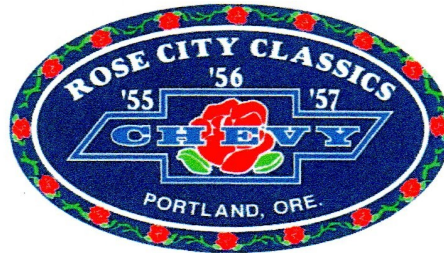

This letter is to introduce our car club and its members as this year's organizer of the **Woodland Planter's Days Car Cruise** in Woodland, Washington.

If you were a Sponsor last year, thank you for making the 2011 Charity Cruise a big success. Through your generous support, we were able to raise enough money to present a (\$12,935.22) check to *The ALS Association Oregon & SW Washington Chapter*. Please consider supporting us again this year. You'll also be interested to know that, with generous help from businesses and individuals such as yourself, Rose City Classics has been honored to distribute more than \$121,800 to eight different charities since 2004.

Rose City Classics (RCC) is a non-profit automobile club dedicated to the preservation and restoration of the 1955-1957 Chevrolet cars, trucks and Corvettes, as well as overall interest in the automotive hobby. We have been active in the Portland-Vancouver area for over 30 years.

We put on numerous events each year, with the bottom line of this memo to request either a cash or merchandise donation for our major charity event, the **21th Annual Charity Car Show** on **Sunday, June 17, 2012**. We are expecting 300 or more classic cars, hot rods, customs, bikes, and special interest vehicles. The event will be advertised in newspapers and on radio, as part of the **Woodland Planter's Days Celebration and Community Festival**.

This year our car club has selected **RAY HICKEY HOSPICE HOUSE, a program of PeaceHealth Southwest Medical Center**. Built entirely with donor dollars including a lead gift of \$1.5 million from now-deceased local businessman and philanthropist Ray Hickey, this 20-bed inpatient facility opened in 2004. Last year Hospice Southwest provided home-based medical, spiritual and emotional end-of-life care, for 961 people and their families. Hospice House is a beautiful, home-like environment featuring a family space where relatives and friends can gather to share a meal or watch a movie and simply relax. The facility offers a sanctuary/spiritual center for introspection and meditation, and patients and their loved ones may express themselves through art at the Houses' art and activities room. Some overnight accommodations are also available for family members. Their **Federal EIN is 91-1231436**.
